Zambia is a landlocked country in South Africa, located on a plateau and known for its many parks and safari areas, home to a variety of wild animals. On the Zambezi River on the border with Zimbabwe is the famous Victoria Falls, which the indigenous peoples have long called Mosi-oa-Tunya (Thundering Smoke). It plunges into the narrow Batoka gorge from a height of 108 meters. Just below the waterfall, the Victoria Falls Bridge is built, which offers stunning views. - Google
